N	John Murray Macdonald moved from the Hunter Valley to Raglan Station in 1910. After his death in 1957, H.M. Macdonald, his nephew, wife and son Ian, formed the Raglan Pastoral Co. to purchase the station, which Ian McDonald sold in 1983.
DESCRIPTION	Letters, diaries, tax returns, wages books and balance sheets, other financial records, rainfall records relating to Raglan Station and Evandale, near Warwick, including a pocket book with notes from Ben Ean. Also personal diaries, photographs of family members.
